



Gender differences in Hong Kong 86.9 Women are expected 81.2 to live longer Women have **lower** labour force participation rate and median monthly earnings too 68.7% HK\$ HK\$ 17,000 50.7% 13,000 More women receive old-age 96,800 87,700 allowance from the government

Women are less confident both in knowledge and skills






Women are *vulnerable* regarding some financial behaviours

- provide timely bite-sized information via social media




Train the ambassadors
